I am writing in reference to your letter of October 2, 2002, a copy of which is attached, referencing late filing of the referenced Campaign Finance Report filed on September 25, 2002. Your letter states that the report was originally due on September 5th, but not received until September 25th, therefore assessing a late fee of \$800.00 due by date of this letter.


After careful discussion with department personnel, it was determined that the report was not due to your office until September 25th, 2002 due to the fact that Chief Menard did not receive funds from any one contributor in excess of \$200 nor did he himself expend more than \$200 of his own dollars. After careful analysis of contributions received it was determined that his finance report was not due until September, 25th, 2002.

It was determined that I inadvertently included a receipt in total contributions, which was actually an order, but had not been paid for prior to this filing. This made it seem as though Chief Menard had spent more than his allowable \$200.00 for the reporting period.


The Louisiana Board of Ethics has received your 30-P campaign finance disclosure report, which was due by September 5, 2002. The report was filed on September 25, 2002 and was 20 days late. La. R.S. 18:1505.4A(2)(a)(iii) of the Campaign Finance Disclosure Act provides that an automatic late fee of \$40 per day be assessed against you for this late filing.

Accordingly, a late fee of \$800 is assessed against you for failure to timely file your campaign finance disclosure report. Please submit a check or money order payable to the Treasurer of the State of Louisiana to 2415 Quail Drive, Baton Rouge, LA 70808 by November 4, 2002.

La. R.S. 42:1157 provides that the late filer may apply to the Board for a waiver of these late fees, but only for "good cause shown." "Good cause" is defined in the statute to be "any actions or circumstances which, in the considered judgment of the board, were not within the control of the late filer and which were the direct cause of the late filing." The Board may also consider, where applicable, the reason for the failure to file timely, the nature of the office sought, and the significance of the information undisclosed. Should you desire the Board to consider waiving the late fees, submit a written statement to the Board specifying your reasons for the late filing, in lieu of your payment, by November 4, 2002. You should provide specific dates and documentation to support a waiver request. If you would like to appear before the Board in connection with such a request, please so indicate in writing.
