ORDER


This matter came before the Board of Ethics on the 29th day of April, 2009. After considering all available information, the Board on motion duly made and seconded, and by a majority vote rendered the following order:

IT IS ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED that the charges issued against Derrick Shepherd at the April 10, 2008 meeting of the Louisiana Board of Ethics are hereby dismissed in their entirety.

IT IS FURTHER ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED that the Louisiana Board of Ethics dismissed the charges against Derrick Shepherd as a result of the issuance of its Advisory Opinion in BD No. 2009-171, which states that a member of the legislature is not required to file a disclosure statement under Section 1111E(2)(a) of the Code of Ethics until such time as the member of the legislature, on behalf of his client, has contact with the State of Louisiana, through one of its departments, agencies, boards, or commissions; or until such time as the member legislator has filed suit on behalf of his client against the State of Louisiana or against one of its departments, agencies, boards, or commissions. Since Derrick Shepherd, while he served as a member of the Louisiana Senate, did not make contact with the Department of Insurance or file suit against the Department of Insurance on behalf of his client, the Louisiana Board of Ethics ordered dismissal of the charges herein.


IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that this matter be dismissed as to
