

**SCHEDULE OF REPORTING AND FILING DATES
PROPOSITION ELECTION**

May 16, 2026

Any person, other than a candidate or committee, who solicits or receives any contribution or makes any expenditure in support of, or opposition to, a proposition or question submitted to the voters is required to file reports of such contributions and expenditures if the total amount of contributions or expenditures equals or exceeds \$5,000. Any candidate or committee who solicits or receives any contribution or makes any expenditure in support of, or opposition to, a proposition or question submitted to the voters is required to file reports of such contributions and expenditures if the total amount of contributions or expenditures equals or exceeds \$5,000. The provisions of the Campaign Finance Disclosure Act that apply to committees apply to persons supporting or opposing propositions. The schedule of the reporting dates for this election is as follows:

1. Date received either physically or electronically, by facsimile or e-mail, in the office of the supervisory committee or date of postmark or date received on a return receipt requested form from the United States Post Office or receipt or invoice from commercial delivery service. **Committees and other persons that receive contributions in excess of \$50,000 or make expenditures in excess of \$50,000 in a calendar year, other than a committee of a recognized political party, are required to file campaign finance disclosure reports ELECTRONICALLY using the Board of Ethics Computerized Data Management System (LEADERS).**
2. Special Reports: A special report must be filed if, during the 20 days preceding the election, a contribution in excess of \$5,000 is received or an expenditure in excess of \$5,000 made. The report is due within 48 hours of the transaction.
3. 40th day after the election is the last report filed provided no financial activity related to this proposition occurs for the remaining **2026** calendar year.
4. Supplemental Report: If there is any financial activity related to this proposition election from **June 16, 2026** through **December 31, 2026**, a supplemental report should be filed by **March 1, 2027**.
